Father Max Oliva is a speaker, consultant, and author on the topic of ethical decision-making in the workplace. He now makes his home next to Gonzaga University. As of August, 2019, he is Chaplain to the University Business School . His undergraduate degree is in Marketing and he has an MBA in Organizational Behavior from the University of California at Berkeley in addition to a Masters in Divinity.

Father Oliva taught ethical decision-making to adult learners in the School of Management at Regis University's Henderson, Nevada campus. He began presenting seminars and talks on ethics and spirituality to companies and business associations while living in Calgary, Alberta, Canada, from 2001 to 2008. In the fall of 2008 he was a Visiting Scholar at the Markkula Center for Applied Ethics at Santa Clara University. He moved to Las Vegas, Nevada, in 2011 where he continued to minister to men and women in the corporate sector. While living in Las Vegas, he wrote a monthly column on ethics for Las Vegas Business Press, a weekly magazine published by the Las Vegas Review Journal, for four years. He continues to work in Las Vegas, on a part-time basis.

In addition to his ministry at Gonzaga, Father assists Father Tim Clancy at Our Lady of the Lake Church in Suncrest, Washington on Sundays and is the Chaplain to the Parish's Knights of Columbus Council.

Father Oliva is the author of seven books. The latest, *Becoming a Person of Mercy*, is part practical guide, part spiritual refreshment and part small-group handbook. Each chapter contains questions for reflection and discussion to help us discern how God calls us to extend mercy to others, to his own creation, and especially to ourselves.
